I am pleased to announce the location of the fourth annual Boutique Mountaineering Camp! Please join us in the remote Gothic Glacier area of the Selkirk Mountains, seldom visited, with a number of peaks in close proximity and excellent rock routes in a comfortable setting.

We'll have a spectacular campsite situated near treeline at the toe of the Adamant Glacier. Basecamp will be situated around 2 kilometers of *Mount Fria*, *Gibraltar Peak*, *Mount Wotan* and *Azimuth Peak*. *Blackfriars*, *East Peak of the Gothics*, and *Adamant Mt.* are outstanding, technical climbs around 4.5 kms from basecamp. *Pioneer Peak*, the *Gargoyle* and *Yggdrasil Mt.* are less technical peaks between 3 and 4 kms from our proposed basecamp. There is a beautiful meadow adorned with a spectacular waterfall that is 500' vertical feet above base camp.

I am very excited to be able to offer you the opportunity to experience the *Gothic - Adamant* area in the comfort and exclusivity of the now tried and true Boutique Mountain Camp format. The area offers numerous objectives in close proximity to our basecamp as well as some longer days that will test the more adventurous explorer. The routes will vary from walk-ups to cool, technical routes. Our low client - guide ratio (2-3 clients per guide/leader) will allow us a lot of flexibility with climbing objectives. As well, if we run into a patch of poor weather there are many wonderful hiking opportunities. Depending on demand we will also offer snow, rock and ice schools during the week.

The actual basecamp will be comfortably located and stocked with a number of amenities. It will definitely be a wonderful place to hang out if you feel like taking a day off.

The BMC will be based out of Golden, BC. Participants will drive 2 hours or take the van, provided by Rocky Mtn Safaris, to the helicopter staging area on the west side of Kinbasket Lake near the Gold River estuary. From the staging area you will be flown to the basecamp.

The camp will operate on a seven-day, Sunday to Sunday, basis. Your camp fees will cover private tent accommodation, guiding, catering, and helicopter transportation for you and your gear. All applicable taxes are included in the camp fee. There will also be instruction in a number of disciplines, sumptuous meals and all group climbing equipment.
